An imposing free-standing fire grate with column legs, large ball finials and an immense burning area. The back plate sits over the original fire brick and depicts the bull & bear, the two symbolic beasts of finance.

The grate was manufactured by Warings of Liverpool, a furniture maker, founded by John Waring in the 19th century. Circa 1900
